

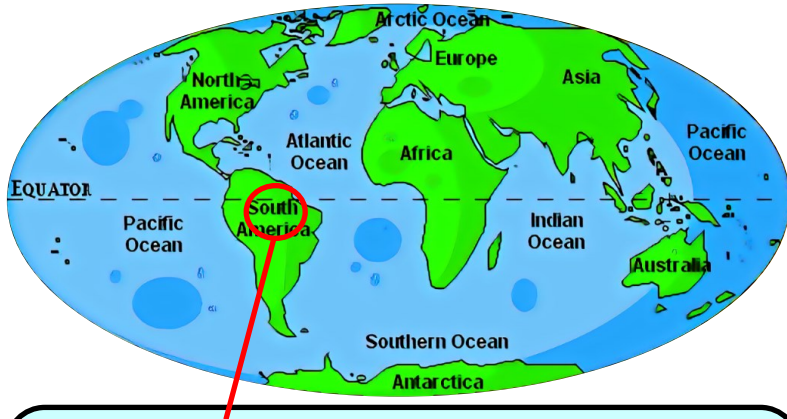

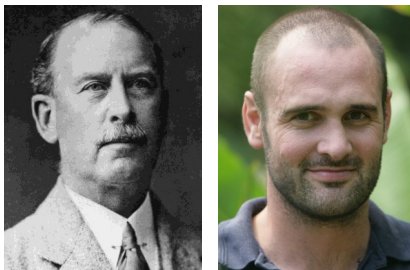


A food chain shows how animals depend on other plants and animals for food and survival.
