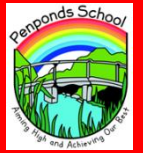




# PENPONDS PRIMARY SCHOOL

| <b>If there was an emergency at school, what would you do?</b>                    | <b>Tell an adult<br/>Follow all instructions given<br/>Stay calm and quiet</b>   |

| <b>What does online safety mean to you? Why is it important?</b>                  | <b>Being careful online<br/>Not messaging or talking to strangers online<br/>Be kind to others online<br/>Don't click on things that you don't know what it is<br/>Don't share address or what school you go to<br/>It's important because you can be tracked down, scammed, you could be taken away, you could be robbed.</b> |
| <b>If a friend is worried about an issue outside of school what would you do?</b> | <b>Tell an adult at school.<br/>Tell my parents<br/>Encourage your friend to tell a grown up at school themselves<br/>If it is really serious call the police or Childline</b>   |
| <b>What would you do if you were worried about a test you were about to take?</b> | <b>Ask a teacher or parent for more help<br/>Study and revise more<br/>Tell your teacher you are worried</b>   |
