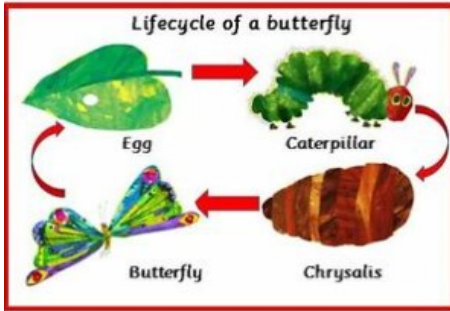

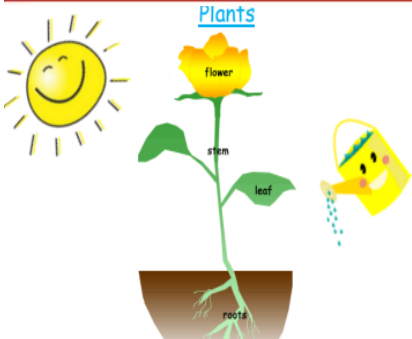


Look how humans change and grow!

What changes do you see?

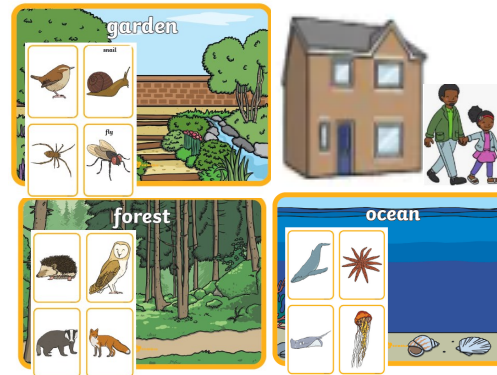
Changes in the seasons: winter to spring

Christian's believe that God created the world by making changes each day.

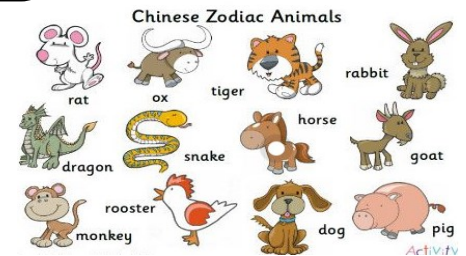
